LAMBERT-ST. LOUIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT NO SMOKING POLICY

Lambert-St. Louis International Airport and its facilities are smoke free. Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas that are set a minimum of 15 feet away from outside entrances. The use of electronic smoking devices is also limited to the designated smoking areas.

This policy is in accordance with the St. Louis County Clean Air Code. Violators could be subject to a citation and a fine.
